
About AdvantAge Ontario



Who Should Take This Program?

Prerequisites include a minimum of three years in a managerial or supervisory role, and a post-secondary degree or diploma. What's Included

Course fees include in-person or live online training, plus 15 hours of on-demand video learning modules, and electronic copies of all course materials provided in advance of the program. Students who attend an in-person program also receive breakfast and lunch.

Long-Term Care Management Training Program

Our Management Training Program builds organizational capacity by providing comprehensive, practical training for long-term care and seniors' housing managers at all stages of their careers.

The Long-Term Care Management Training Program (MTP) is a unique, four-month program that covers core management skills including leadership, communication, motivation, delegation, and more. Participants receive expert, one-on-one coaching in an area of their choice and have the opportunity to network with peers during virtual learning modules and online coffee house sessions. The program is suitable for both new and experienced managers, and there are no educational or other prerequisites required.


Applied Management: What You'll Learn


